Emergency Medical Technician

Career Pathway

JOB DESCRIPTION:

EMTs are medically trained clinicians providing live saving services to their community - offering first line emergency care and transportation for patients with acute medical issues. Situations range from managing life threatening issues occurring in a patient's home or work site (such as cardiac arrest), to handling traumatic injuries at an accident scene.

SALARY RANGE:

\$11 - \$20 hourly

ADDITIONAL TRAINING:

EMT Course (3-11 weeks)

- Learn about first response treatment, patient assessment, basic life support and CPR, moving and transporting patients, and working alongside other medical professionals
- Can be all in the classroom or a classroom/ online hybrid

PREREQUISITE:

- Must be 18 years old
- High School Diploma preferred but not required
- Volunteer experience at a hospital or other medical setting helpful



EMPLOYMENT:

Work as an EMT

 May work for local or private ambulance companies, hospitals, police / fire departments, or armed services.



- Pass the National EMT exam
- Pass your state's EMT licensing exam
